*There won't be a pool in our holiday home.* W naszym domu letnim **nie będzie** basenu.
- W pytaniach stosujemy inwersję, czyli szyk przestawny:  
*Is there a poster on the wall?*  
*Will there be any plants in here?*  
*Was there a vase on the table?*

Just Enough Room island

Look at the photo. At first sight, it seems as if it is a flooded area. Maybe <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ somebody inside who needs help? Luckily, that is not true. It is Hub Island – the smallest inhabited island in the world. Apart from this tiny piece of land, <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ over a thousand islands on the St. Lawrence River, on the border <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ the USA and Canada.

Now the land is known as Just Enough Room Island. The family that bought it in 1950 changed its name because the place was so small. They planned to have a cosy holiday home <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ a quiet area to get away from city life. But when they built it, a lot of tourists started visiting it and the family gave up the holiday idea.

The land is the size of a tennis court and measures just 306 square metres, so <sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ just enough space for the cottage. <sup>6</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ several rooms inside: three bedrooms, a living room, a bathroom and a big kitchen. <sup>7</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ also a pair of deck chairs and a tree outside the house.
